Oppose the Wine Country Specific Plan

The City Council will be voting to approve the Wine Country Specific Plan on

Wednesday, March 27 at 5:00 pm at the Yucaipa Performing Arts Center (12062 California St)

By the City's own admission this plan will completely change the culture of Yucaipa. With as many as 26 commercial wineries and wine-tasting rooms mixed with higher density housing (up to 4.3 houses per acre) on nearly 2 square miles of the North Bench, this plan violates Yucaipa's General Plan for minimum lot size and rural living and will:

- Considerably <u>increase traffic congestion</u> throughout Yucaipa by adding commercial wineries, wine tasting, large events along with 1,080 total homes on densified, smaller lots;
- ✓ Significantly increase potential DUI accidents, injuries, and deaths, since access to the wineries will be via,
 - ☐ Residential one lane roads with no shoulders or sidewalks (Ivy, Carter, Fir, and Oak Glen Roads),
 - □ Roads used by children and residents for jogging, cycling, horseback-riding, and other activities,
 - Roads directly accessing many of Yucaipa's schools including elementary schools and Yucaipa High School, and
 - Roads accessing youth soccer fields and Community Park.
